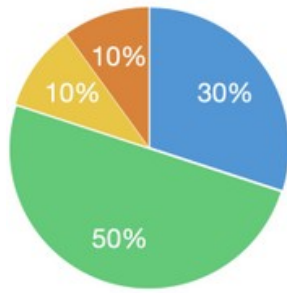


A-F Accountability System

The State of Arizona A-F Accountability System, is designed to award letter grades to schools based on a range of academic measures. For elementary schools, these measures include the following:



K-8

- Proficiency (30%) in English Language Arts and Mathematics on state assessments
- Growth (50%) in English Language Arts and Mathematics on state assessments from the prior year
- English Learners (10%) Proficiency and Growth based on AZELLA testing
- Acceleration and Readiness (10%) measures, which include improvement of chronic absenteeism and improvement in sub-group performance on state assessments

2023 Letter Grade Breakdown

The most recent letter grades issued by the Arizona Department of Education are based on data collected from the 2022-2023 school year. Each school is awarded a percentage of points earned, and then assigned a letter grade based on that overall score.
