Dear Families,

At Laveen, we offer two after-school options: Academies and Enrichment Programs. What's the difference?

After-school Academies are academic tutoring programs offered to individual students that would benefit from additional instruction to either accelerate their learning (they have fallen behind) or advance their learning (they need to be academically challenged). These academies are offered by teachers and require an invitation. They are focused, intentional instructional sessions, not traditional "study halls." If you feel like your child would benefit from attending an academic academy, please contact his/her teacher directly.

After-school Enrichment Programs are exploratory opportunities for students to learn new skills, meet new friends with similar interests and have fun! Examples include clubs and sports teams. Teachers act as program advisors or coaches. The current list of opportunities will change based on student interests. If your child has an idea for an after-school enrichment program, all he/she needs to do is find a teacher to act as the advisor! If your student is interested in a current program, please contact the teacher advisor/coach for more information.
