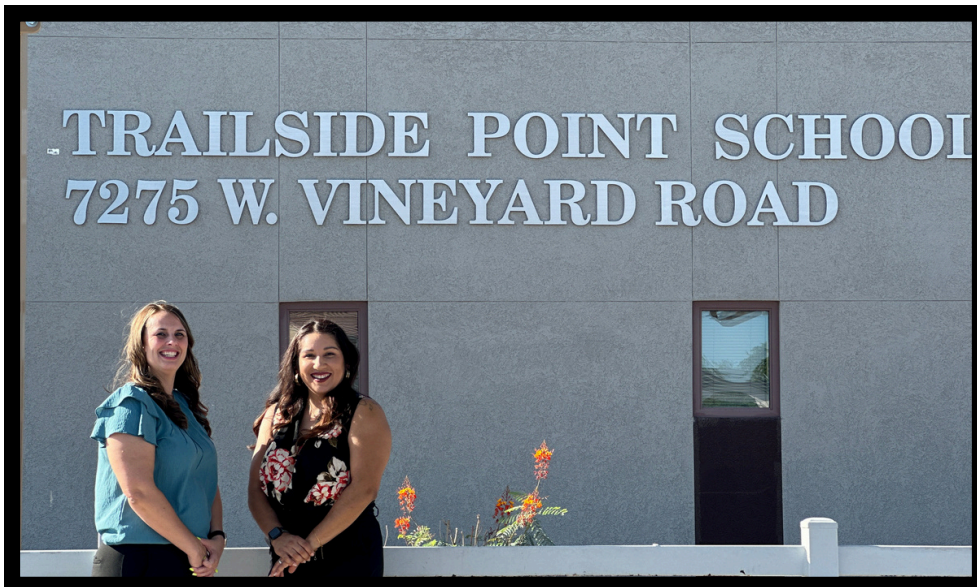

WHAT'S NEW WHEN YOU STEP ON CAMPUS

You may notice something different this year with dismissal. In order to keep everyone safe we are implementing a new procedure for dismissal.

ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL ROUTINE

ARRIVAL 7:00-7:25 AM

- All walkers and drop off students will enter through the front gates of the school.
- Bus riders will use the west gates.
- All students will need their ID and be in uniform to enter campus, if they do not have their ID or uniform, students will be asked to enter through the front office and will receive a written redirect.
- Please have your child ready to exit the car when you pull up to the exit spot.
- The front gate will close at 7:25. Student who arrive after, will need to enter through the front office.

DISMISSAL 2:30-2:50 PM

- Walkers will dismiss from both the west and east side of the school using the gates. If your child lives on the west side of the school, they will use the west gates behind the bus bay. If your child lives on the east side of the school they will use the gates by the park to exit campus.
- Car pick up: Parents please stay in your car and have your car sign visible (given at Meet the Teacher Night). A staff member with a radio will call your child's name. Your child will be in a classroom waiting for their name to be called. Please pull forward and wait for your child to exit through the front gates.
- If your child has a younger sibling in K-2 and is a walker they will meet at the sibling tree (located in the courtyard).

Early Release is **EVERY** Wednesday at 1:00 pm



Regular attendance and punctuality are crucial for your child's success at Trailside.

When children attend school consistently and arrive on time, they not only keep up with their studies but also develop important habits of responsibility and time management. These habits will benefit them throughout their educational journey and beyond.

- Excused and unexcused absences represent lost time in the classroom and lost opportunities to learn.
- Missing just one day every two weeks can add up to 18 days in a year. Absences add up before you even know it.



10 TO 17 DAYS

- Students who are absent an average of 15 days a year miss a year's worth of school before their senior year.
- When students miss a day of school it actually puts them two days behind their classmates.



9 OR FEWER ABSENCES

- Students with good attendance generally achieve higher grades and enjoy school more.
- Children benefit and make the most of their educational opportunities if they attend school regularly and on time.
